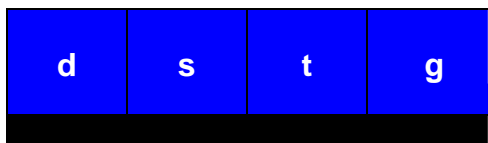

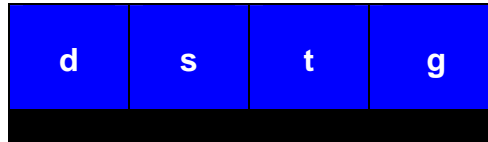

Professor Callum Youngson

Head of School and Professor/HonConsultant in Restorative Dentistry. School of Dentistry. University of Liverpool.

Dr. Paul Averley

Paul has been involved in establishing conscious sedation services in primary care since 1997. He has developed an evidence base for new conscious sedation techniques and was awarded a MPhil in 2003 and a PhD in 2005. Paul has been actively involved with several national guidance documents on conscious sedation including the 2010 NICE guideline for the use of sedation in children for therapeutic and diagnostic procedures. Locally Paul is involved with the Local Dental Committee. He is a member of the Oral Health Advisory Group and is a champion of primary care research and holds an honorary position at the University of Newcastle.

Dr Anna-Maria Rollin

Dr Rollin is a distinguished anaesthetist who has served on several national committees concerned with standards in GA and sedation. She is currently a member of the Intercollegiate Advisory Committee for Sedation in Dentistry. She is Professional Standards Adviser for the Royal College of Anaesthetists, past Senior Vice-President of the Royal College of Anaesthetists. Lead Assessor for Anaesthesia (General Medical Council) and past-president, Section of Anaesthesia, Royal Society of Medicine.

Professor Paul Coulthard

Professor of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of Manchester and Consultant and

Clinical Lead for Oral Surgery at Central Manchester NHS Foundation Trust. Paul has worked in General Dental Practice and also held a resident SHO post in Anaesthesia. He completed his Higher Specialist Surgical Training in Academic OMFS in 2000, which included the award of an MDS in OMFS and a PhD in Neuroscience, and was promoted to Senior Lecturer and Head of Department the same year, Honorary Consultant in 2001, and Personal Chair in 2004. He is an Editor with the Cochrane Collaboration Oral Health Group and is on the Editorial Board of the *International Journal of Surgery, Oral Surgery* and the *Chinese Journal of Clinicians*. He has a special interest in the *Control of Pain and Anxiety* and *Dental Implantology* and has published over 140 scientific papers. He was a previous Chair of DSTG.

Carole Boyle

Consultant in Special Care Dentistry in the Department of Sedation and Special Care Dentistry at Guy's & St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust London.

President elect of SAAD. Past Chairman Dental Sedation Teachers Group. Carole's particular interests are using sedation for people who require special care and teaching sedation to both undergraduate and postgraduate students. Carole has held appointments in oral surgery, anaesthesia and general dental practice.

Dr Paul Redmond

Dr. Paul Redmond is head of Careers and Employability at the University of Liverpool and one of the country's leading experts on

generational theory and the graduate labour market. An experienced writer and speaker, Paul has presented at numerous events and conferences both in the UK and overseas.

In addition to writing regularly for the *Guardian*, his research has featured in most leading UK newspapers.
